
East Ender's Saturday Morning Breakfast

VP's Corner



Happy New Year everyone! I hope this finds you snug as a bug in a rug. In other words, nice and warm inside your home

since outside it's without a doubt, winter.

Now, I figure 99.9% of us are NOT out and about driving in our MG, and there are several members of the club that are retired and go south for the winter. I've often wondered if any of these folks ever take their MG with them, or do they just leave their car in this winter wonderland? I'm guessing most abandon their MG and head to the sunshine states by any means possible. OK, not really abandon their MG but I'm wondering who takes care of their car/s when they are gone? One would think it's OK to just park it and forget about it but that's really not a good idea. Whether you go south for the winter or stay here during the winter months, your MG still needs some attention. It's always a good idea to park your car where you can still move it around. I don't mean start it, I mean give it a gentle push back and forth changing the location where it sits. This will prevent you from getting flat spots on your tires and prevent the brake pads from rusting to the rotors. Now, if you're one of those folks who likes to suspend your car on jack stands, of course rolling your car back and forth is "*Out of the Question!*" If you do store your car on jack stands, I hope you placed the stands under the outer portion of the front A Arms and under the leaf springs where the U bolts surround the axle and spring. This will keep the suspension from dropping away from the body and straining the shocks and the rebound rubbers/straps.

It's also highly recommended you exercise those pedals. The brake and clutch pedal should be exercised at least once or twice a month. This will keep the cylinders from freezing up or losing their seal. It's a good idea to exercise the hand brake too; this can prevent the cable or linkages from freezing in position. But be sure to store your MG with the handbrake OFF!

One last thing. I hope you can store your car in a nice clean, dry and rodent-free environment. If you put your car away with the top down and with leftover scraps of food, wrappers, pop cans, etc. you must drop this newsletter (once

you've finish reading my column) and get those items out of the car and put that top up! It sounds crazy but I know folks who have parked their car in that condition when putting it in storage. Case in point: several years ago, when I was helping in the shop, we had a customer's car brought in right from its winter storage for a tune-up. The owner left food wrappers and even some clothes in the car (great items for mice to make a home in). The worst part was in the boot (trunk), they left a can of pop which froze and exploded all over the place. What a STICKY mess!

Whether you stay here for the winter or travel south, be sure to check on your car while it's in storage. And if you can't check on it yourself, have someone do the checking for you. You'll be glad you did because when spring arrives you won't want any surprises. You'll just want to get in the car and hit the road! I know it's January, but spring will be here before you know it.

Well now that the holidays are behind us, Steve and I look forward to snow. Yes, I said snow! About six years ago Steve made up his mind he wanted to have something "fun" to do during the winter months. He remembered years past when he and his brothers had good times snowmobiling, so Steve found us some used sleds. Now when winter is upon us we do the next best thing to driving an MG, we go snowmobiling! We have access to some great trails right out our back door, so I say.... If it's going to be winter, "Let It Snow!!" Hopefully we will get out riding and I'll have some stories to share with you in the upcoming months.


