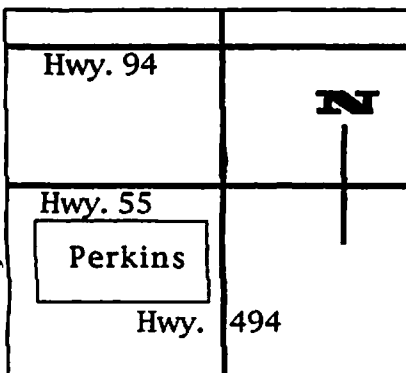
Jim & Joleen Lymburn will be co-hosting this years summer picnic and fun day at the "MadsonCompound"

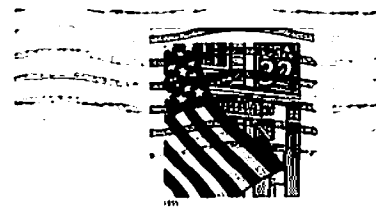
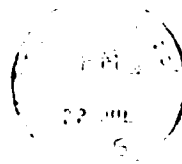
